

The finishing level of the movement for the Orion series, named *Luxurious D4*, is the highest offered by the Sellita. It includes a main plate with circular graining, snailing on the bevels, crown wheel, ratchet, and barrel, all nickel-plated.

The Sellita Cal. SW288-1 A, introduced in 2018, is a automatic-winding movement featuring a refined moon phase and date display, inspired by the ETA 2800 family. It is distinguished by a large central moon phase disc and a discreet date window at 6:00, offering a blend of elegance and precision.

The oscillating weight is inspired by the *Moon XVIII* card from the Tarot de Marseille, drawn by Jean Dodal in the 17th century. This piece is manufactured by AJS Production in Switzerland.
